



Health Care Flexible Spending Account with Carryover

Under the Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS), a **Health Care Flexible Spending Account (HCFSA)** is a pre-tax benefit account used to pay for eligible medical, dental and vision care expenses that aren't covered by your health care plan. With an HCFSA you can save up to 30%* on eligible health care expenses and, with Carryover, there's virtually no "use or lose" risk. Eligible health care expenses include menstrual care products and over-the-counter (OTC) drugs like aspirin and cough medicine without a prescription, in addition to face masks and hand sanitizing wipes (with 60%+ alcohol base).

Please note: If you were enrolled in a 2021 HCFSA, recent legislation allows carry over of all remaining funds in your 2021 HCFSA when you re-enroll in a 2022 HCFSA.
